WHAT DOES STUDDARD FINANCIAL, LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security Number and Income
- Account Balances and Transaction History
- Assets and Employment History

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice

How?

All financial companies need to share clients' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons companies can share their clients' personal information; the reasons Studdard Financial, LLC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • <i>Studdard Financial, LLC does not share with affiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • <i>Studdard Financial, LLC does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • <i>Studdard Financial, LLC does not jointly market.</i>
Other important information	
We share your trade data including the name of the security, number of shares, and dates owned with Chicago Clearing Corporation (CCC) for the purposes of tracking and filing claims in the event of future litigation. CCC handles all aspects of the claim filing process in exchange for a portion of the recovered amount.
